

Headband

Materials

- *1 50g (83m) hank Mirasol Qina (80% Baby Alpaca, 20% Bamboo) or any knitting worsted/aran yarn to obtain the required gauge
- *one pair each of 3mm and 4mm needles



Gauge

20 sts and 40 rows = 4"(10cm) in fisherman's rib with 4mm needles

Fisherman's Rib

p1, knit next st in the row below; rep from, end p2. Repeat this row.



Finished size is approximately 19.5 inches around

Headband

With 3mm needles cast on 20 sts. Work in k1,p1 rib for 3 3/4 inches ending with the RS row. Next row (WS) p1, m1, purl across to last st, m1, p1 (22 sts). Change to 4mm needles and work in fisherman's rib until this section measures 12 inches. End with WS facing. Change to 3mm needles, p1, p2tog, purl to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1 (20sts). Continue in k1,p1 rib until this section measures 3 3/4 inches. Bind off on WS.

Finishing

Sew the 2 smaller rib sections together at the back.

Centre front piece: With 3mm needles cast on 10 sts. Work in k1,p1 rib for 4 inches. Cast off. Wrap this piece around centre front section of headband, stitching edges together on WS. Tack in place on both long edges on the inside.

Abbreviations

- k - knit
- m1 - make one - Increase by inserting left needle from front to back under the horizontal strand between last stitch worked and next stitch on left needle, forming loop on left needle, knit in back loop of this stitch.
- p - purl
- p2tog - purl two together
- rep - repeat
- RS - right side
- st(s) - stitch or stitches
- WS - wrong side
